

#### Investment Objective

The Fund aims to achieve long-term capital growth by investing in a diversified portfolio of equity and fixed income securities. The Fund aims to provide excess return over the composite benchmark, 50% Philippine Stock Exchange index (PSEI) and 50% return of the 91-day Philippine Treasury Bill, net of tax.

#### Manager's Report

**Local Market Review:** The Philippine market proved strong in October, shaking off news of the US government shutdown and speculations of a possible US default. The index surged 3.36%, closing at a level of 6,585.38. The local bourse was largely supported by domestic investors while foreign investors turned net sellers as they sold into the rally. Robust macroeconomic factors buoyed investor sentiment as reflected by the recent Moody's upgrade of the Philippines to investment grade with a positive outlook. As a result, the domestic market largely outperformed other regions (MSCI Asia Ex-Japan +4.64%, MSCI World +3.83%).

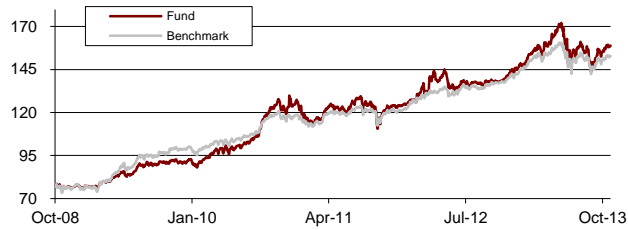
SM Prime Holdings, Inc. (SMPH) was the biggest gainer, rising 19.73%, after the merger between SM Land and SMPH was disclosed on Oct. 25, 2013. Megaworld Corporation (MEG), up 17.79%, was not far behind; gaining on speculations of a possible MSCI inclusion in November.

Sentiment moving forward may be driven by third quarter earnings results, net foreign flows, and capital raising activities.

**Fund Performance:** The Fund gained 4.06% for the month against its benchmark's 3.19% advance.

**Strategy:** We plan to take advantage of expected weakness (possible re-testing 6,375) and pick up undervalued stocks. We maintain our overweight calls on property, conglomerates, and consumer names. We may also build some positions on a number of defensive stocks.

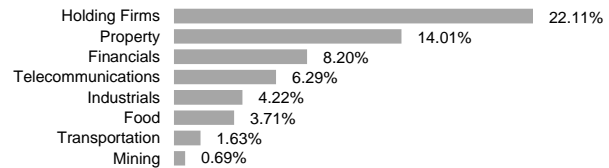
